

# Campus Protection Plan (CPP) - Campus Experience Real Madrid Foundation 2026

The Campus Protection Plan (CPP) is an optional service that offers participants greater flexibility in case of cancellations or date changes, in accordance with the conditions established in the Cancellation Policy of the Campus Experience Real Madrid Foundation 2026.

The CPP can **only be purchased at the time of registration and is non-refundable** under any circumstances, neither fully nor partially, even if the reservation is later cancelled.

## 1. Requirements to activate the CPP

For the CPP to be valid, the following conditions must be met:

- The full amount of the reservation must be paid at least 60 days prior to the start of the campus.
- The **cancellation or date-change** request must be submitted within the deadlines established in the **Cancellation Policy**.

#### 2. Benefits of the CPP

The Campus Protection Plan allows participants to:

- Extend the cancellation period with the right to partial refund:
  - With the CPP, participants may cancel up to 30 days before the start of the campus, receiving a 75% refund of the amount paid or choosing a date change.
  - For cancellations made more than 60 days in advance, the refund will be 80%, or a date change may be requested.
- Request date changes at no additional cost:

If the participant is unable to attend on the scheduled dates, the CPP allows the reservation to be rescheduled for another Campus Experience Madrid 2026, within the cancellation deadlines established.

### 3. CPP exclusions

The CPP does not cover:

- Voluntary withdrawal of the participant.
- Disciplinary expulsion.
- Cancellations made outside the established deadlines or with incomplete payments.
- Additional expenses.
- Medical, travel or visa insurance.
